REGULAR SEASON SCHEDULE

The Commodores will have no availability on Sundays and Mondays.

Each Tuesday, starting at 12:15 pm CT, Vanderbilt hosts an on-campus press conference with Coach Mason and select players.

After Wednesday practices, select players & coaches will be available starting at about 8:45 am CT. Coach Mason's segment of SEC Head Coaches Teleconference starts Wednesday, Aug. 30, at 10:30 am.

PRESEASON COVERAGE

The first week of preseason camp will be open to local media outlets. The Commodores will conduct morning practices for the third consecutive year. Typical practices conclude about 9 a.m.

ONLINE CREDENTIALING

The online resource to submit credential requests to Vanderbilt home games follows: **www.SportsSystems/Vanderbilt**

All applications will be notified of their status at least one week before gameday. Approvals will not be granted without acceptance of SEC credential and media policies.

When possible, credentials will be mailed one week in advance. However, credentials can be picked up on Fridays before games at the VU Communications office in McGugin Center (2601 Jess Neely Dr.). On gamedays, **Media Will Call is located at Gate 1** (stadium gate closest to Marriott & Wendy's).

GAMEDAY MEDIA PARKING

If authorized, media parking is located in Kensington Garage next to Memorial Gym. Please access the garage entrance off 25th Avenue South. All media representatives must have a proper credential to access parking garage.

PRESS BOX & IN-GAME FIELD ACCESS

Media must wear **"MEDIA"** or **"PHOTO"** credentials to gain access to the press box. The field elevator is located near Gate 1. Seating charts will be posted.

Field access is restricted to working photojournalists from kickoff until 5:00 remaining in the game. All photographers must wear a **"PHOTO"** armband.

PRESS BOX WIRELESS & PHOTO TRANSMISSION

The press box is equipped with wireless internet access for the working press. Visiting photographers should plan to transmit from the press box.

TV production crews should order phone lines in advance. To order, call (615) 343-2012.

MASON'S POSTGAME REMARKS

Coach Mason's post-game press conference is held after he addresses the team. **Only properly credentialed media will be allowed into the conference.**

Writers can access the field level for the final 5:00 of the fourth quarter. The best option for Dudley Field access is the Press Box northside elevator.

The location in Vanderbilt Stadium for postgame press conferences is next to the Commodore locker room. Access to the conference room is available in the south end zone field tunnel. The visiting conference room is directly across from Vanderbilt's press facility.

VANDERBILT PLAYER POSTGAME AVAILABILITY

The Vanderbilt Locker Room is closed. Select student-athletes will be made available for post-game interviews. These interviews will be conducted in the same room as Coach Mason's remarks. The players will enter when Mason concludes.

The visiting team interview room can also be accessed from the south end zone tunnel. It is directly across from Vanderbilt's interview room.

FISHER ANCHORS RADIO NETWORK

Joe Fisher, Norman Jordan and Mitch Light provide concise and insightful Commodore coverage on the Vanderbilt Radio Network.

A Nashville native, Fisher enters his 20th season as the team's play-by-play announcer. He handles similar duties for Vanderbilt men's basketball and baseball. Fisher also serves as Vanderbilt Athletics' Director of Broadcasting.

Prior to joining Vanderbilt, Fisher was a television sports anchor in the

Nashville market from 1987-96, with stints at WSMV-4 and WKRN-2. He also worked in public relations.

Jordan, a former Vanderbilt standout running back who helped the Commodores to a 1982 Hall of Fame Bowl appearance, returns for his third year at analyst. He works as a stock broker in Nashville.

Light enters his fifth season providing sideline commentary. Light is a Vanderbilt graduate and editor of Athlon sports publications.

DIRECTIONS TO VANDERBILT STADIUM

ARRIVING FROM SOUTH OF NASHVILLE

Take I-65 North to I-40 West to Exit 209A (Broadway-West End). Turn left to go west on Broadway. When Broadway splits, stay to the right to enter West End Ave. Take West End past the University's three high-rise dorms and turn left on 25th Ave. Garage access is one block on right, just before Memorial Gym.

ARRIVING FROM NORTH OF NASHVILLE

Take I-65 South into downtown and take Exit 209B (Broadway-West End). Turn right on Broadway. When Broadway splits, stay to the right to enter West End Avenue. Take West End past the University on the left, turn left on 25th Avenue. Access into Kensington Garage is a block on right just before Memorial Gym.

ARRIVING FROM EAST OF NASHVILLE

Take I-40 West/I-65 North downtown to Exit 209A (Broadway-West End). Turn left at light, headed west on Broadway. When Broadway splits, veer right to enter West End Ave. Take West End past the University's three high-rise dorms and turn left on 25th Ave. Garage access is one block on right, just before Memorial Gym.

ARRIVING FROM WEST OF NASHVILLE

Take I-40 East to I-440 East. Take the first exit (Murphy Road-West End) and turn left at redlight. In .25 mile, turn left onto West End. The campus will be on your right. Turn right on 25th Avenue (one block past Wendy's). Kensington Garage access is one block on right, just before Memorial Gym.

ARRIVING FROM CHATTANOOGA/ATLANTA

Take I-24 West to I-440 West. Take Exit 1 (West End Avenue). Stay right off the exit onto West End. The Vanderbilt campus will be on your right. Turn right on 25th Avenue (one block past Wendy's). Kensington Garage access is one block on right, just before Memorial Gym.

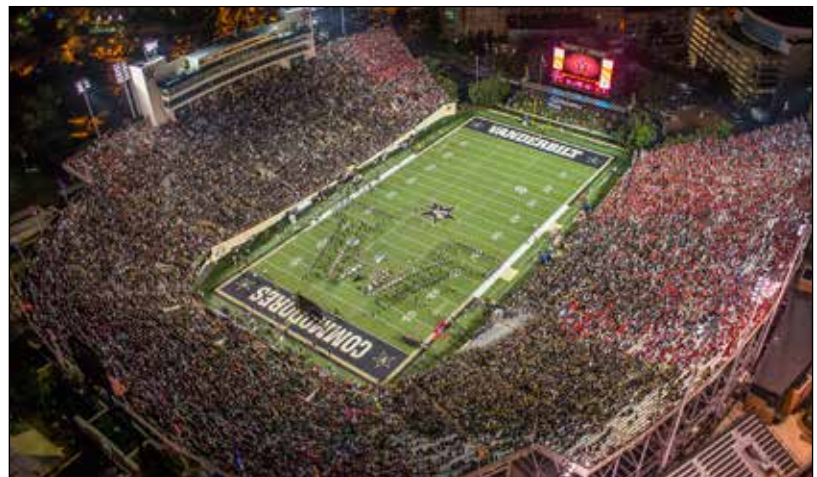
VANDERBILT STADIUM: COMMODORE HOME SINCE 1981

Several improvements have been made to 40,350-capacity Vanderbilt Stadium, which has served as home to the Commodores since 1981.

The gameday experience in Vanderbilt's on-campus venue were substantially improved in 2013 with the construction of a 450-capacity hillside berm next to the north end zone. Behind the berm, university officials installed a new video board that more than doubled the size of the stadium's former visual board.

Vanderbilt Stadium's Dudley Field playing surface, where the 'Dores have played dating back to 1922, also has received recent updates. In 2012, it returned to a synthetic surface for the first time in more than a decade when the university decided to add cushioned Shaw Sportexe turf. The surface has drawn rave reviews from players, who also benefited with the addition of new stadium lights the same year.

The 2012 work adds to other major recent improvements. A thorough exterior renovation was completed in 2010, including new plazas and entrances at Gates 2 & 3 and an exterior effort to unify Vanderbilt Stadium, Hawkins Field and Memorial Gym.
