### LAST TIME

Vanderbilt won its second straight two-point decision, this time against Austin Peay on December 17 at Memorial Gym in a 58-56 decision against the Governors. Freshman Damian Jones scored 12 points to lead all Commodore scorers, with Rod Odom adding 11 points and Kyle Fuller pitching in 10 points. Odom also added a career-high nine rebounds. Vanderbilt moved to 3-0 on the season when Jones leads the team in scoring, even though the Commodores shot a season-low 37.3% from the floor.

### MCCLELLAN

Sophomore guard Eric McClellan, an Austin, Texas, native, tallied a career-high 29 points in Vanderbilt's game at Butler, and is the team's leading scorer with 15.7 ppg. McClellan has scored in double figures all but two contests this season (Marshall and Austin Peay), and also averages 5.0 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game.

### SPREAD THE WEALTH

Seven of the team's nine scholarship players scored in double figures this season, with Dai-Jon Parker and Shelby Moats the only ones not to reach double digits.

### ALL-TIME VU WINS

Head Coach Kevin Stallings, who won his 279th career game with Vanderbilt against Lipscomb on November 15, is now the all-time Vanderbilt wins leader, surpassing legendary coach Roy Skinner. Stallings now has 283 wins at Vanderbilt, is the wins leader at Memorial Gym with 191, and has 406 victories as a head coach.

### HOME

Vanderbilt is in the midst of a five-game homestand, which began with the Marshall game on December 5. After playing their first eight games of the season (through Marshall game) in 23 days, Vanderbilt only has three games in 25 days (Austin Peay, 12/17; Georgia Tech, 12/21; St. Louis, 12/30) beginning with the game with the Governors on December 17.

### HENDERSON

Redshirt Junior Josh Henderson who was averaging 6.6 points and 4.3 rebounds per game this season, tore his ACL, MCL and lateral meniscus against Marshall on December 5 and will miss the rest of the 2013-14 campaign. Expected recovery is eight to nine months.

### NEWCOMERS

The three Vanderbilt newcomers this season, Eric McClellan, Damian Jones, and Luke Kornet, have accounted for 262 points this season, or 40.5% of the team's offensive production.

## RECAP &amp; NOTES

NASHVILLE - Kyle Fuller scored all 10 of his points in the final 6:22 including 5 of 6 free throws to help host Vanderbilt defeat neighboring Austin Peay 58-56 on Tuesday night.

Freshman Damian Jones scored 12 points, and Rod Odom added 11 points and nine rebounds for the Commodores (6-3).

Chris Horton's 16 points and 10 rebounds led the Governors (5-6), while Will Triggs chipped in 11 points.

Fuller sank a pair of free throws with 15.8 seconds remaining for a 57-53 advantage. But Travis Betran hit a long 3-pointer to trim it to 58-56 before Fuller hit his final foul shot with 8.2 seconds left. Peay missed a chance at the buzzer.

Demarius Smith's 3-pointer pulled Austin Peay even at 50-50, but Fuller made a steal and drove the lane for the go-ahead score. After a James Siakam block, Fuller's first free throws gave the Commodores a 54-50 lead with 1:23 to play.

The Governors' Zavion Williams had three straight baskets including two transition scores to push Peay ahead 43-41. Fuller's 3-pointer ended the drought for a 44-43 cushion and Siakam scored Vanderbilt's next six points for a 50-47 margin.

Siakam didn't play the first 10 minutes for Vanderbilt, which was already down to eight scholarship players after losing redshirt junior Josh Henderson for the season. Henderson suffered a severe knee injury in the Commodores' last outing, 12 days ago in a win over Marshall.

Austin Peay extended its 22-20 halftime lead to 24-20 on Triggs' basket to open the second half. But Vanderbilt went on a 6-0 spurt to retake the lead on two straight baskets by Jones.

Peay's Smith picked up back-to-back fouls for his third and fourth fouls with 13:37 to play, and Jones hit both free throws for a 33-30 lead.

Vanderbilt's Eric McClellan opened the game by scoring the first four points on fast breaks including a dunk. Smith, however, hit a 3-pointer for Peay and Horton's bucket gave the Gobs a 5-4 lead.

Seven-foot freshman Luke Kornet, playing center, hit a pair of 3-pointers that put the Commodores back up 7-5 and ahead 14-11 after Horton's baseline jumper tied it 11-11. The second trey started a 6-0 Commodores run for the biggest lead of the first half at 17-11.

Betran's three-point play put the Gobs on top 20-18 on a high layup that almost hit the top of the backboard. Jones charged on the other end for his second straight foul.

Jones' basket tied it 20-20, however, to break a nearly 8-minute stretch without a field goal for Vanderbilt. But Horton's inside bucket gave Austin Peay the halftime lead 22-20 to cap a 7-2 run.

## HISTORIC MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM IN 62ND SEASON

Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 62nd season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 850 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renowned for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.

- The Commodores own a 38-33 advantage in the overall series, and a 13-1 record against the Yellow Jackets in Memorial Gym. Georgia Tech and Vanderbilt were both charter members of the SEC in 1932, with the Jackets leaving the league in 1964.
- Since Georgia Tech left the conference in 1964, the teams have met five other times, with the Jackets winning three of the five meetings. The last meeting came on December 6, 2008, a game Georgia Tech won, 63-51, in Atlanta.
- Guard Trae Golden is 2-1 against the Commodores at Memorial Gym. The UT transfer averaged 5.7 ppg in those three games.

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 874 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank second only to UNLV for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

## EUROPE

In August, the Commodores ventured to Greece and Italy for a 10-day tour of the two countries, which included two games against a French Division I All-Star team in Greece and two against an Italian Division III squad in Rome. Vanderbilt came away 4-0 on the trip. Freshman Damian Jones, who only played in the two games in Greece because of a school obligation, led the team with 13 points per game. In four games, Eric McClellan averaged 12.3 points per game, Rod Odom 11.5 points per contest, Dai-Jon Parker 10.3 per game, and Josh Henderson 10.0 points per game.

ST. THOMAS, USVI - Tyler Harris scored 15 points, including a key 3-pointer during a late 18-0 run, as Providence won 67-60 in a thrilling come-from-behind victory over Vanderbilt in the Paradise Jam.

Providence trailed 56-40 with 10:42 left, but caught fire and Vanderbilt crashed and burned. The Friars held Vanderbilt scoreless for nearly 9 minutes, ending on Rod Odom's 3-pointer to give Vanderbilt a 59-57 lead with 2:55 left.

Providence scored the next eight points to build its biggest lead of the game at 65-59. The Friars hadn't led since 9-7 early in the game.  
Bryce Cotton added 14 for Providence (5-0) and LaDontae Henton had 12.  
Odom led Vanderbilt (2-2) with 17 points, Eric McClellan added 13 and Josh Henderson tied a career-high with 13 points. Henderson scored a combined 11 points in Vanderbilt's first three games, 6, 1, and 4 respectively.

The Friars will play the winner of the Morgan State-La Salle matchup.  
Throughout most of the second half, Providence couldn't get the stops when it needed to. The Friars didn't score more than five consecutive points in the second half until the 6:34 mark.  
But Providence rallied back, going on an 18-0 run, with 3-pointers by Harris, Kris Dunn and a three-point play by Carson Desrosiers.  
Damian Jones missed two crucial free throws with 3:53 left that would have given Vanderbilt its first points in nearly 7 minutes.

Providence trailed for a majority of the first half too. The Friars were held to without a field goal for over 4 minutes, but LaDontae Henton's 3-pointer pulled the Friars to 19-18 with 7:43 left.  
Vanderbilt led 31-22 with 1:41 remaining but did not make a field goal in the final 2 minutes and Providence scored the next four to trail 31-26 at halftime.  
Providence was held to 34.5 percent shooting, including 2 of 15 3-pointers, in the first half.

Kevin Stallings commented at halftime about Vanderbilt's defense in the first half, saying "...defensively, that's the best 20 minutes of basketball we've played this season."

Vanderbilt out-rebounded the Friars 23-15 in the opening half and made 42 percent of its shots, mostly coming in the paint.

AUSTIN - Isaiah Taylor had 14 points and eight assists and Texas won its first game against a power conference team this season in a 70-64 victory over Vanderbilt on Monday.

Demarcus Holland and Javan Felix each scored 12 points for Texas (7-1). Felix went 2 of 3 from beyond the arc and Kendall Yancy contributed 11 points and six rebounds.

The Longhorns led by as many as 13 points in the second half and were able to hold off Vanderbilt (4-3), which trimmed the Longhorns lead to one point in the final minute after an Eric McClellan steal and dunk.

Felix sunk a pair of key free throws to make it 65-62 before Holland's three-point play with 12.6 seconds left sealed the win.

Austin native McClellan scored a team-high 22 points for Vanderbilt while Josh Henderson scored 12 points on 5 of 8 shooting and Rod Odom had 11 points.

Texas needed second-half comebacks in four of its previous six wins this year but started the game on an 8-2 run and never looked back. The Longhorns led for the final 39 minutes of the game, using a 16-3 run to take a 31-25 halftime lead.

Vanderbilt trimmed Texas' lead to three points when Henderson knocked down a jumper to make it 57-54 with 2:30 left to play.

Then, Taylor helped the Longhorns take control of the game down the stretch. He completed a three-point play and hit a floater following a steal by Holland all in less than 30 seconds to give Texas a 62-54 lead with 1:47 to go.

The Longhorns initially struggled from the free throw line, making just 10 of 16 attempts before knocking down five straight in the final 24 seconds.

Texas, whose victory Monday came in the first-ever Big 12-SEC challenge, has now won 46 consecutive home games against unranked non-conference opponents. The Longhorns have also won seven of their first eight games for the first time in three years.

NASHVILLE - Vanderbilt held on to win the game with a money shot and a big stop, but also lost a seasoned player to injury in a 69-67 victory over Marshall.

Dai-Jon Parker sank a 3-pointer just inside the final minute to give the Commodores (5-3) a 69-65 lead over the hard-charging Thundering Herd (4-4). Shawn Smith sank his final two free throws and Marshall had a chance to tie it on a drive into the paint before James Siakam stole the ball.

"We changed and had a small lineup, not knowing they also changed and had a small lineup," VU Coach Kevin Stallings said. "James (Siakam) came off and defended on a ball screen. He tends to give guards trouble because he has a seven-foot wingspan. Obviously their coach thought he got fouled."

"James made a very good defensive play. I'm proud of him for that nine seconds - at that point anything can happen."

Siakam and freshman center Damian Jones scored 15 points apiece, and Rod Odom added 11 points including two 3-pointers.

Vanderbilt junior center Josh Henderson, however, suffered a knee injury at 11:15 of the first half right after back-to-back blocks by his teammates on a Herd fast break. Initial indications are a torn ACL and MCL, with an MRI scheduled to confirm the damage.

"It's tough because he was playing well," Stallings said. "He really improved in the offseason and had three really good games in a row. I'm disappointed for him."

Jones, starting his fifth straight game, played a career-high 28 minutes and was a force inside. Marshall Coach Tom Herrion said the freshman from Baton Rouge, La., had the chance to be "something special" and played like he had even more points and rebounds than Jones actually did.

Jones' 3-point play a half-second before intermission handed Vanderbilt the largest lead of the first half at 35-26. He powered in a basket after halftime, then slammed in a dunk on a loose ball for a 41-30 advantage.

Point guard Kareem Canty, last week's Conference USA freshman of the week, led the Thundering Herd with 18 points. His third 3-pointer of the game cut what had been a 13-point lead to 66-65, and Marshall put the ball in Canty's hands for the chance to tie.
