• Tre' McLean leads the Mocs in scoring with 15.0 points per game. Justin Tuoyo (13.6) and Greg Pryor (13.2) also average double figures.

• Saturday will be the 17th overall meeting between the two schools, and the first since Nov. 25, 2001, in a meeting at the Hawaii Pacific Thanksgiving Tournament in Honolulu. Vanderbilt won that game, 69-57.

• The last meeting between the two schools at Memorial Gym came on Dec. 3, 1986, in a 93-64 Commodore win. Vanderbilt is 13-3 all-time against the Mocs, with the first meeting coming in the 1908-09 season.

• The Mocs sport two players from Nashville - sophomore Andrew Fleming, who is sitting out this season after transferring from Iowa, and Makinde London, who is averaging 8.2 points and 4.6 rebounds per game.

Senior center Luke Kornet has been named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll in the three years he has played at Vanderbilt, and also been named a CoSida All-District Academic Selection in his sophomore and junior seasons. He was also recently named to the NABC Good Works team for his work in the Vanderbilt and Nashville communities.

Kornet is double majoring in computer science and mathematics.

Memorial Gym close to 1,000

The matchup with Chattanooga will be the 993rd regular season game played at Memorial Gym.

The Commodores have a 776-216 record at the SEC's oldest facility, a winning percentage of .782.

Dores Drain Threes

Vanderbilt made 19 threes against High Point on December 6, which set a new school record for threes in a game, surpassing an 18-three performance at Tennessee on January 8, 2005.

The Commodores also set a new record for most 3-pointers made at Memorial Gym, passing the old mark of 16 that was set on Jan. 8, 1994 vs. South Carolina and then matched on Feb. 11, 1995 vs. Arkansas. The Commodores hit 12 of their 19 3-pointers in the first half.

Four with 25+ threes

Four returning Commodores made 25 or more threes a year ago, with Matthew Fisher-Davis leading the way with 79. Riley LaChance (43), Jeff Roberson (30), and Luke Kornet (26) also eclipsed the 25 made three mark.

Returning for VU

57.3% of the team's scoring returns from a year ago, along with six players who played 28 or more games and four players who made 19 or more starts.


Head Coach Bryce Drew inked his first signing class in November, signing 6'2 guard Maxwell Evans, from Houston, Texas, 6'2 guard Saben Lee, from Tempe, Ariz., and Ejike Obinna, a 6'9 center from Enugu, Nigeria.

Evans is the number 16-ranked prospect in the state of Texas and 247sports.com ranks him as the 11th-ranked combo guard nationally.

Lee is a four-star prospect and the number 92-ranked player by Scout.com and the number 17 point guard by 247sports.com.

Obinna attends the Virginia Academy in Ashburn, Va., is a 4-star prospect by ESPN. com and Rivals.com, and is the 107th-ranked prospect in the class of 2017 by 247sports. com.

The Commodores have a 58-9 record all-time against members of the Southern Conference. Chattanooga is the only Southern Conference team on this year's regular season schedule.

974

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 974 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank second only to UNLV for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

NBA Commodores

Vanderbilt was one of only three schools (Kentucky, Washington) with two first-round selections in the 2016 NBA Draft when Wade Baldwin IV was drafted 17th by the Memphis Grizzlies and Damian Jones was selected 30th by the Golden State Warriors. Baldwin IV and Jones became the sixth and seventh first-round picks, respectively, in the history of the program, joining Will Perdue in 1988 (11th, Chicago), Jeff Turner in 1984 (7th, New Jersey), Clyde Lee in 1966 (3rd, San Francisco), and John Jenkins (23rd, Atlanta), and Festus Ezeli (30th, Golden State) in 2012.

2015-16 National Statistics

In 2015-16, the Commodores finished in a tie for third nationally in three-point field goal percentage defense, limiting opponents to only 29.4% from three. Vanderbilt also finished fifth in field goal percentage defense (38.6%) and ninth in blocks per game (5.5). Luke Kornet tied for third nationally in blocks, averaging 3.0 per contest.

Commodore Postseason History

The Commodores have been named to 14 NCAA Tournaments and 12 NIT's. Vanderbilt advanced to the Elite 8 in 1965 (field of 23), and the Sweet 16 in 1988, 1993, 2004, and 2007. The Commodores captured the NIT Championship in 1990 and finished runner-up in 1994.

Vanderbilt Coaching History

Brvce Drew is the ninth Commodore basketball coach of the modern era and the 27th all time.

Vanderbilt Basktball History

This is the 114th year of Vanderbilt basketball, with the first season taking place in 1900-01. There were no teams in 1904-05 and 1905-06.

GAME 11 - CHATTANOOGA

Murfreesboro, Tenn. (AP) -- Giddy Potts scored 27 points and Middle Tennessee won its third straight over an SEC opponent with a 71-48 win over Vanderbilt on Thursday night.

Potts made four 3-pointers and grabbed nine rebounds in the Blue Raiders' seventh straight win.

Reggie Upshaw added 14 points, six rebounds and five assists for the Blue Raiders, ranked fifth in the RPI ratings. Arkansas transfer JaCorey Williams had 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Matthew Fisher-Davis led Vanderbilt (5-5) with 13 points and Jeff Roberson scored 11.

The Commodores struggled offensively, hitting 32 percent from the floor on 17-of-53 shooting.

Two nights after breaking a school record with 19 3-pointers in a win over High Point, Vanderbilt made 5 of 19 from beyond the arc.

MTSU went 7 of 24 from beyond the arc.

Xavier Habersham's 3-pointer capped a 14-1 run, giving MTSU a 21-12 lead with 7:49 left in the first half.

Vanderbilt went scoreless for 8:29 during that stretch as it shot 0 for 11 from the floor.

Middle Tennessee, off to its best start in five years, took a 31-23 lead into halftime before pulling away during the final 20 minutes.

MTSU has won 72 of its last 84 games at the Murphy Center.

The Blue Raiders narrowed the series deficit to 29-6.

MEMORIAL MAGIC - THE HOME TO VANDERBILT HOOPS SINCE 1952

HISTORIC MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM IN 65TH SEASON

Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 65th season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 950 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renown for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.

2016-17 VANDERBILT BASKETBALL NOTES

VANDERBILT BASKETBALL QUICK HITTERS

• This is the 114th year of Vanderbilt basketball, with the first season taking place in 1900-01. There were no teams in 1904-05 and 1905-06.

• The Commodores have been named to 14 NCAA Tournaments and 12 NIT's. Vanderbilt advanced to the Elite 8 in 1965 (field of 23), and the Sweet 16 in 1988, 1993, 2004, and 2007. The Commodores captured the NIT Championship in 1990 and finished runner-up in 1994.

• The Commodores are a charter member of the SEC, with the 2016-17 season being the 83rd year in the conference.

• Vanderbilt is the only private institution in the SEC with the lowest enrollment of any of the 14 schools (6,738).

 Vanderbilt's Perry Wallace became the first African-American scholarship basketball player in the SEC when he took the court in 1967.

• The Commodores have 44 career 1,000-point scorers, with Shan Foster (2004-08) the all-time leading scorer with 2,011 career points.

• Vanderbilt has had 12 All-Americans since 1950. They are: Billy Joe Adcock (1950), Clyde Lee (1965), Tom Hagan (1969), Jan van Breda Kolff (1974), Will Perdue (1988), Billy McCaffrey (1993), Dan Langhi (2000), Matt Freije (2004), Derrick Byars (2007), Shan Foster (2008), and John Jenkins (2011).

• Vanderbilt had two players selected in the 2016 NBA Draft - Wade Baldwin IV, Memphis, 17th pick and Damian Jones, Golden State 30th pick - one of only three schools with two or more players drafted in the first round. In all, 37 Vanderbilt players have been selected in the NBA Draft since 1950.

• The Commodores had three players drafted in the first 31 picks of the 2012 NBA Draft - John Jenkins, Atlanta, 23rd pick, Festus Ezeli, Golden State, 30th pick, Jeffery Taylor, Charlotte, 31st pick - the most by the Commodores in one draft.

• The Commodores ended a 61-year SEC Tournament drought in 2012 by claiming the tournament championship in New Orleans, the team's first SEC tournament championship since 1951.

• Kevin Stallings is the winningest coach in Vanderbilt history with 322 total victories (17 years, 322-220).

• All three of the university's top all-time scorers played for Kevin Stallings (Foster, Jeffery Taylor, Matt Freije). John Jenkins, who is 10th on the list, also played for him.

• Vanderbilt's intercollegiate athletics teams are nicknamed the Commodores, in honor of the nickname given to founder Cornelius Vanderbilt, who made his fortune in shipping. Vanderbilt donated \$1 million to begin "Central University" in 1875 - the campus was later renamed for Cornelius because of his generosity. Cornelius never stepped foot on the campus that bears his namesake.
