#### Reconnaissance

- ★ This will be the second all-time meeting between Vanderbilt and Winthrop.
- ★ Vanderbilt won the only other encounter, 92-79, in the 2018-19 season opener in Memorial Gym.
- ★ Vandy's lineup in the 2018 opener included three future NBA players in Darius Garland (24 points), Saben Lee (12 points) and Aaron Nesmith (4 points).
- ★ Vanderbilt is 14-0 all-time against the Big South, and most recently defeated Radford in Nashville last season, 59-50.

#### **Looking Astern**

- ★ Jordan Wright led the Commodores with 15 points and seven rebounds in Vandy's 48-37 loss on Wednesday versus VCU.
- ★ The Dores forced 22 turnovers but could not overcome 21 of their own against VCU.
- ★ Vanderbilt opened the season with home nonconference wins over Alabama State (91-72) and Texas State (79-60).

#### **VCU Debrief**

- ★ Vandy trailed by one at halftime but was outscored by 10 in the second half.
- ★ Jordan Wright scored in double figures for the eighth straight regular season game.
- ★ For the second time this season, Vanderbilt forced 20plus turnovers. The Dores turned VCU over 22 times and forced Alabama State into 24 turnovers.
- ★ Vanderbilt has used the same starting lineup in every game—Pippen, Wright, Millora-Brown, Lawrence and Stute. Last season, Vanderbilt used 18 different starting lineups in its 25 games (14 different Commodores started at least one
- ★ Jordan Wright has the longest active games started streak for Vanderbilt at 18 in a row.
- ★ Trey Thomas continued Vanderbilt's longest active games played streak at 28 in a row (every game over the past two seasons).
- ★ Jerry Stackhouse Quotable: "Most nights I come in here and I look on (the box score) and we hold a team defensively to 32% shooting, around 30% from 3 and they only shot 60-something percent from the line, you feel like we would win that game. But when I go and look at our side of it, and we're 2 for 25 from 3 with looks that we know that we can make, it's disappointing to see."

#### **Keys to Victory**

- ★ Dating back to last season, Vanderbilt is 11-2 when tied or leading at the half and 0-15 when trailing at the break.
- ★ Dating back to last season, Vanderbilt is 9-3 when scoring 75 or more and 2-14 when scoring less than 75.
- ★ Vanderbilt has hit the 80-point mark 15 times in the Coach Stackhouse era with a 12-3 record in those games, including 12-1 in regulation (only regulation loss was Jan. 9, 2021 against Mississippi State, 84-81). In four of the six SEC wins under Coach Stackhouse, Vanderbilt has eclipsed that 80-point mark.

#### Fire Away

- ★ Vanderbilt has made at least two 3s in every game in 2021-22 and has done so in 43 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 25, 2020 when the Commodores were held without a 3 for the first time in 1,080 games.
- ★ The Commodores ranked second in the SEC in made 3s per game (9.3) last season.

#### **Pippen Preseason Prognostications**

- ★ Junior guard Scotty Pippen Jr. earned several preseason honors this offseason, including:
- ★ NABC Player of the Year watch list
- ★ Wooden Award watch list
- ★ Lute Olson National Player of the Year watch list
- ★ Naismith Trophy watch list
- ★ Bob Cousy Award preseason watch list
- ★ Preseason SEC Player of the Year
- ★ Preseason First-Team All-SEC (media and coaches)

#### **Pippen Points**

- ★ Scotty Pippen Jr. is now 106 points from reaching 1,000 for his career (currently at 894).
- ★ Pippen was second in the SEC last season with 20.8 points per game and 4.9 assists per game.
- ★ Pippen set the school scoring record for a sophomore (20.8 ppg) and was third in the NCAA among sophomores in scoring—first among power conference players.
- ★ Pippen also finished ninth in school history with 4.9 assists per game last season, was seventh all-time among Vandy sophomores with 457 points, and finished with the 10th-most assists (107) by a sophomore at Vanderbilt.
- ★ Pippen finished seventh in the nation with 142 made free throws and third in the NCAA with 6.5 made free throws per game. Only five players in the country got to the line more often than Pippen's 7.6 free throw attempts per game.
- ★ Pippen scored at least 20+ points 12 times and 30+ points three times last season, including a career-high 36 at Cincinnati. He matched or upped his career-high point total on six different occasions in 2020-21, and led the team in scoring 13 times, while also leading the Dores in assists 17 times in his 22 games played.

#### Infirmary

- ★ Both graduate transfers will miss the start of the season due to injury. Dayton transfer, Rodney Chatman, suffered a knee injury the week prior to the start of the season and is expected to miss at least a month. Minnesota transfer, Liam Robbins, is recovering from a foot injury and remains weekto-week to make his Commodore debut.
- ★ Last season, Vanderbilt had 12 of its 17 players miss games due to injury or illness. In all, the Commodores amassed 62 missed games: Odusipe (2), Wright (2), Harvey (2), Pippen (3), Millora-Brown (3), Weikert (3), McBride (3), Stute (4), Disu (7), Albert (7), Brown (8), Lawrence (17).

#### **Graduate Transfers**

- ★ Seven-foot center Liam Robbins, who was named to the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year award watch list, joined the Commodores after earning his degree in business marketing and education from the University of Minnesota where he led the Big Ten and ranked 10th in the nation in blocks last season. He averaged 11.7 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.7 blocks while shooting 44 percent and starting all 23 games he played. He also ranked 11th in the conference in rebounding and seventh in offensive rebounding.
- ★ Rodney Chatman recently graduated from Dayton with a degree in education and played two seasons with the Flyers. As a junior, he led the third-ranked Flyers in steals (40) and was second in assists (99) as Dayton finished 29-2 and was projected as a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament before it was canceled. Last season, Chatman missed 12 games due to a hand injury, but returned for the final six games of the season. Prior to his injury, Chatman started the first six games and averaged 10.0 points, 4.2 assists and 2.5 steals.

#### Freshman Class

- ★ All four members of Vanderbilt's freshman class made their collegiate debuts in the season-opening win against Alabama State on Nov. 10—Peyton Daniels, Gabe Dorsey, Shane Dezonie and Graham Calton.
- ★ Daniels, Dezonie and Dorsey each received four-star ratings, while Graham Calton joined the squad as a walk-on.
- ★ Daniels, a 6-foot-2 guard, was a first-team all-state selection at Tri-Cities (Ga.), while Dorsey, a 6-foot-6 wing, set the career record for made threes at The Hill School as a junior.
- ★ Dezonie was originally committed to the University Arizona, but joined the Dores in the summer and was the No. 86 recruit in the nation according to rivals and No. 96 from 247Sports.

#### **Two More Transfers**

- ★ Terren Frank spent his freshman campaign at TCU last season. The 6-foot-8 forward was No. 90 in the ESPN Top 100 recruits out of Sierra Canyon High School.
- ★ Jamaine Mann played 26 games and started 10 as a freshman at Gardner-Webb in 2020-21. He averaged 6.8 points and 5.3 rebounds per game, and shot 51.6 percent from the field in 20.8 minutes per game. A native of Hampton, Georgia, he was a three-star prospect and rated as high as the No. 13 recruit in the state.

#### **Adding to Memorial Magic**

- ★ Memorial Gymnasium underwent several upgrades over the summer to enhance the fan experience.
- ★ New concessions are available, including Slim and Husky's, Kernels Popcorn, and a refillable drink option.
- ★ Eight new LED display boards along the corner walls, and two LED ribbon boards along the lower mezzanine baseline. Video boards and LED ribbon boards have also been added to portions of Memorial's lobbies.
- ★ A new court design featuring a more prominent Star V logo at center court and Vanderbilt branding.
- ★ Last summer, as part of a \$5 million gift from Seattlearea businessman and Vanderbilt alumnus George B. Huber, BA'79, and his wife Cathy, Vanderbilt's basketball practice facility underwent extensive upgrades—branded paint and graphics throughout the gym, environmentconscious LED lighting and an all-new playing surface.

#### **Out of Port**

- ★ Vanderbilt played three true road games in the final five days of the 2020-21 regular season—the Commodores were at LSU for a Tuesday night tilt, at Cincinnati on Thursday night and at Ole Miss Saturday evening.
- ★ Vandy was the first major conference team to play three road games against three different opponents over a span of five days since Boston College did it in February 2000 (one of their opponents was Vanderbilt).

#### Commodores in the NBA

★ Vanderbilt has four active NBA players. Aaron Nesmith (Celtics), Saban Lee (Pistons), Darius Garland (Cavaliers) and Damian Jones (Kings) represent the Commodores. ★ In the 2020 NBA Draft, Nesmith was selected 14th

overall by the Boston Celtics, while Lee was selected 38th overall by the Detroit Pistons. It marked the first time a pair of Vanderbilt players were selected in the NBA Draft since 2016.

#### Vanderbilt Hall of Fame

- ★ Eleven Vanderbilt Athletics Hall of Fame inductees were announced on Nov. 13 by vice chancellor and athletics director Candice Lee, including former Commodore student-athlete and head coach Jan van Breda Kolff.
- ★ One of the all-time great Commodores, van Breda Kolff led the Vandy to an SEC championship as a studentathlete in 1974 and returned to his alma mater where he won 104 games as a head coach. Van Breda Kolff still holds the school record with 5.38 assists/game and remains the only player in school history to average more than 5.0 assists/game in three different seasons. His 430 total assists still rank fifth all-time at Vanderbilt.
- ★ Members of the 2021 induction class will be recognized Jan. 28-30, with the official induction ceremony taking place Jan. 28 at the Vanderbilt Student Life Center. After the induction ceremony, the honorees will be recognized at the men's and women's basketball games during that weekend. The additions will bring the number of Hall of Fame inductees to 82 since it was established in 2008.

#### Vandy United

- ★ As part of the \$300 million Vandy United campaign for athletics, Vanderbilt University announced its plans for a new basketball operations center which included:
- ★ Multi-floor building with two practice gyms spanning more than 90,000 square feet located in current north end zone of Vanderbilt Stadium
- ★ New student-athlete locker rooms and lounges
- ★ New athletic training facility and new weight room
- ★ Convenient access to Memorial Gymnasium
- ★ Aiming to break ground in fall 2022

★ Vanderbilt won its fifth straight season opener and its 15th straight home opener, dating back to 2006.


